Amalfi Coast

The Amalfi Coast is a approximately 50-kilometer-long stretch of coastline along the southern edge of the Sorrento Peninsula in the Campania region of southern Italy. Renowned for its cliffs, colorful villages, and stunning Mediterranean landscapes, it was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997. The coastline is dotted with charming towns such as Positano and Amalfi, connected by the scenic SS163 cliffside road. Blending historic architecture, natural beauty, and Mediterranean charm, the region attracts a large number of visitors each year who come to experience its unique culture and natural allure.





Positano



Positano is a town located along the Amalfi Coast in the Campania region of Italy. The main part of the town is nestled between mountains and faces the sea, making it a retreat for social elites. The Amalfi Coast is renowned as one of the most beautiful coastlines in Europe, featuring a winding shoreline with towering islands, dramatic cliffs, and alternating valleys and headlands. Orchards and wild vegetation thrive side by side, blending rich human history with pristine natural surroundings. Throughout the lush forests, numerous picturesque towns are scattered, and the most beautiful among them is called Positano. The American writer John Steinbeck described it this way in a 1953 issue of *Harper's BAZAAR* "Positano is a dream place that isn't quite real when you are there and becomes beckoningly real after you have gone." allure.

Ravello
